## 2022-23 SCHOLARSHIP

<u>Purpose</u>: This scholarship provides financial aid to promising elementary and/or secondary orchestral instrument and/or vocal students who need assistance in meeting the cost of private lessons *during the coming 2022-2023 academic year*. Scholarships will be awarded for two (2) or more lessons depending on the need, merit and number of students applying. A check will be issued upon receipt of the "Letter of Intent" form co-signed by teacher and student.

Please note the eligibility requirements that are in **bold italics**. Also, you may apply for **either** a Friends Scholarship or the Phil Musician's Professional Scholarship **but not both**.

## **Eligibility Requirements & Instructions:**

- Applicants must be in *grades 3-12 for the 2022-2023 school year*
- Applicants must have studied with their current teacher for at least one year prior to application date.
- Vocal students must be at least 13 years old (male voices must have changed)
- Instruments must be orchestral instruments (includes piano & organ)
- Application must be complete and returned by the deadline
- Teacher Recommendation Form is to be submitted by music instructor/teacher (mailed by teacher)

#### **Scholarship Deadlines & Notifications**

**October 1, 2022** is the postmark deadline for all applications. Student application forms and Teacher Recommendation forms may be mailed separately, but all forms must be on time. Please mail materials to:
