Their missions are to empower children by providing an intensive orchestra training program that teaches the importance of teamwork, promotes self-confidence, and instills the value of social responsibility.

Club Orchestra: Students will lay the musical groundwork to play in an orchestra and end the year with a performance with the Fort Wayne Philharmonic.

- Open to 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students attending Forest Park, South Wayne, and Waynedale Elementary Schools
 - Begins September 12 and continues through the school year
 - Rehearsals meet after school Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday, until 5:00 p.m.
 - Violins and music are provided

Club Kid-O: Students will experience a variety of lessons that incorporate the use of pitch, rhythm, body movement, playing Orff mallet instruments like xylophones, glockenspiels, marimbas and metallophones, all that use mallets. In addition, the children will learn to sing and combine skills to perform throughout the year.

- Open to K and 1st Grade students attending Forest Park, South Wayne, and Waynedale Elementary Schools
- Begins September 26 and continues through the school year
- Kindergarten and First Grade meet weekly Tuesday & Thursday after school until 5:00 p.m.
- Snacks and restroom break will be given halfway through each rehearsal
- Students are expected to attend daily sessions
