2025 - 2026 Scholarship

<u>Purpose</u>: This scholarship provides financial aid to promising elementary and/or secondary orchestral instrument and/or vocal students who need assistance in meeting the cost of private lessons during the coming 2025-2026 academic year. Scholarships will be awarded for two (2) or more lessons depending on the need, merit and number of students applying. A check will be issued upon receipt of the "Letter of Intent" form co-signed by teacher and student.

Please note the eligibility requirements that are in **bold italics**. Also, you may apply for **either** a Friends Scholarship or the Phil Musician's Professional Scholarship **but not both**.

Eligibility Requirements & Instructions:

- Applicants must be in grades 3-12 for the 2025-2026 school year
- Vocal students must be at least 13 years old (male voices must have changed)
- Instruments must be orchestral instruments (includes piano & organ)
- Application must be complete and returned by the deadline
- Teacher Recommendation Form is to be submitted by music instructor/teacher (mailed by teacher)

Scholarship Deadlines & Notifications

November 1, 2025 is the postmark deadline for all applications. Student application forms and Teacher Recommendation forms may be mailed separately, but all forms must be on time. Please mail materials to:
